

CUSHIONS

Kingsley Bate cushions are designed for style, comfort, and outdoor performance. Our construction uses lock-stitch sewing for superior seam strength. Color coordinated nylon zippers come standard for easy maintenance. Cushions are intended solely for outdoor use.



Boxed Edge
Top and bottom panels are sewn along all edges to a connecting side panel. Boxing may be translated into a variety of cushion-shapes, not limited to squares or rectangles.



Waterfall
Cushions have a seamless, softly rounded front edge made of a single piece of fabric that wraps around the top, front, and bottom of the cushion. Boxing is on the back-edge and sides.



Knife Edge
Top and bottom panels are sewn together so that the seam is centered along the edge. Knife-edge styles are not limited to squares or rectangles.



Welts
Welts come standard on select models or may be added as a custom option. A contrasting welt (different fabric) may be specified on a welted cushion.

3 STEPS FOR SPECIFYING CUSHIONS

1. Choose Fabric – Three Options

Option 1 – Stocked Fabrics

Our range of stocked designer fabrics include two performance levels: Standard and High. Standard Performance fabrics are suited for most outdoor environments, while High Performance options in Sunbrella® Rain are ideal for installations with high exposure to rainfall. **Note:** Sunbrella Rain fabric differs from standard Sunbrella fabric in that it has a back-coating, making it virtually waterproof.

Polyurethane Foam
Open-cell foam has superior responsiveness and elasticity, providing the highest level of comfort, support, and longevity.



Reticulated Foam
Highly porous 'flow-through' foam offers improved drainage over polyurethane foam while having less elasticity and a firmer sit.



Polyester Batting
A soft fiber used to wrap foam for a plush appearance and comfortable feel.



Polyester Pillow Fill
A soft, cottony fiber typically used in back cushions. Offers good support while providing sink-in comfort.



Liner/Casing:
Standard or Water Resistant
A breathable, weather-friendly textile used to encase cushion fill. Made from polyurethane and offered in standard or water resistant versions.

3. Choose Customizations

Customize other elements of your cushions for a truly personalized result. Available options for each cushion model may vary.

- Add or remove a welt
- Specify the welt in a different fabric than the cushion body ('contrasting welt')
- Specify the welt to be cut on the bias
- Replace the welt with C.O.M. braided cording
- Specify different fabrics for seat and back cushions
- Remove ties or fasteners
- Order non-slip pad to help cushions grip frames
